Resuming all square, Pompey start an attack ... maybe Monty planned it. Gaillard has a clear run - but he's missed his chance and Simpson clears.

Walker slams upfield ... Milburn chases the ball. He shoots .. and Newcastle take the lead!

Newcastle again ... Mitchell beats Ferrier.

Robledo has it ... he shoots but the ball hits the post, and rebounds to Butler who clears upfield.

Now Pompey look dangerous. Phillips passes across the goal, Duggie Reid shoots - and it's all square!
