Others live in huts - with their children who have never known what it is to eat enough. And all over Europe there are scenes like this ... more than a million people without hope - or very little. Tuberculosis is rife. Here in Trieste the Swiss Red Cross help the military authorities to fight the scourge ... but the problem of the great unwanted remains unsolved.
