Trieste is a nevralgie point of the world, with its harbor full of in coming and out going carges of goods, it is a union mark between two worlds.

But it also is a refuge for a lot of people who have lost all their hopes and things in the wars, flying from behind the iron curtain they are miserably surviving in dreadful conditions, without hope and even enough to eat. living in former prisons and camps. Russian, Germans out of Russia, Yugoslaves and Czechs, they are all mixed up in narrow quarters, pale children and sick people, ready to become victims of tuberculosis and any other illnesses that come out of poverty.

The Swite Red Cross are helping the military authorities whe are organizing medical tests and visits of these peor people, and shortly will open up Swiss' homes to these children.
