

TRIESTE: ROME DEMONSTRATIONS

Following riots in Trieste, 20,000 students demonstrate in Rome in favour of the return of Trieste, promised by the Allies at some future date.

At the American Embassy, after a student protest about allied-controlled police action against Italian demonstrators in Trieste, Embassy Counsellor Harney assures them that their petition will be forwarded to Washington.

Now the crowd storms towards the Victor Emanuel monument, and students plaster cars with anti-Tito slogans. Part of Trieste is controlled by Yugoslavia, and Zone A (where riots broke out) by Britain and America. Talks on the town's future are now on in London, and these demonstrations which both Fascists and Communists have exploited are not helpful, to say the least of it.
