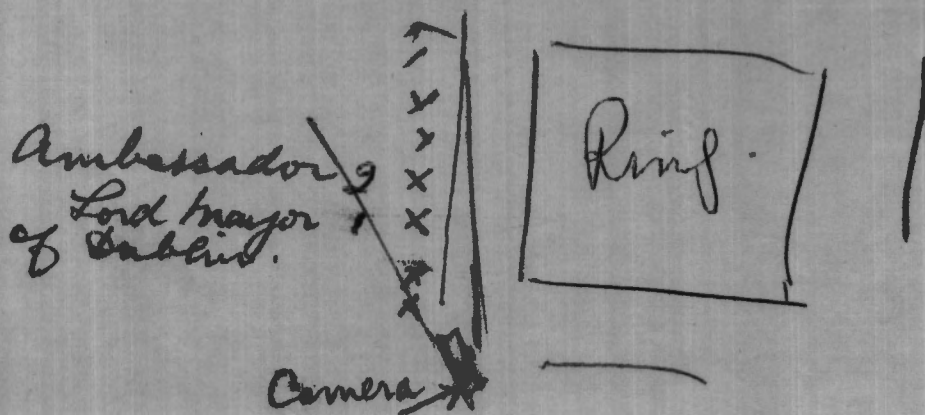

end of 100 ft reel.

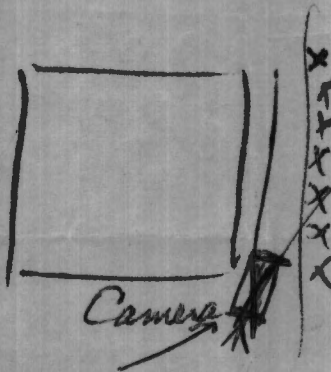
