Flyweight.—A. REDDY. Age 19 years. Occupation, motor mechanic. Champion of Ireland. Has recently defeated the European Champion, A. Pozzali (Italy).

Bantamweight.—J. McNALLY. Age 19 years. Fitter (Engineer). Champion of Ireland.

Featherweight.—T. REDDY. Age 20 years. (Fitter) Engineer. Bantamweight Champion, 1949-'50.

Lightweight.—DAVE CONNELL. Age 25 years. Has represented Ireland on no fewer than 30 different occasions. Travelled to America with the European team, where he won both contests. Has also represented Ireland in the European Championships.

Light-Welterweight.—TERRY MILLIGAN. Age 22 years. Occupation, Aircraft Fitter. Has represented Ireland in the European Championships. Irish Champion 1951-1952.

Welterweight.—PETER CROTTY (Clonmel). Age 25 years. Occupation, Farmer. Champion of Ireland. Travelled as Reserve, European Team against America.

Light-Middleweight.—F. KILMARTIN. Irish Champion. Age 23 years. Occupation, Salesman. A first class boxer of the orthodox style.

Middleweight.—W. DUGGAN. Irish Champion. Age 24 years. Occupation, Motor Engineer. Has represented Ireland on 20 different occasions.

Light-Heavyweight.—R. DONNOLLY (Nemo, Cork). Irish Champion. Has come into first class boxing this year by winning the Cruiserweight Title.

Heavyweight.—J. LYTTLE (Belfast). Represented Ireland against England when he defeated Cpl. A. Worrall.
