This first important moto-cross event, called GRAND PRIX de printemps, grouped British, Dutch and French aces of motocycling.

The track which is very tough, is 1100 meters long and competitors have to cover it twice. Basil Hall the british champion is a great favorite, but so is the frenchman Henri Frantz, and finally the frenchman wins. Hall and Harold Lines, also British, arrive second and third.
