At Louveciennes, where SHAPE Headquarters are situated, General Risenhower is made Citisen of the town, before his departure to the United States and His presidential campaign. Later in the merning, in a coronomy on the Invalides Square, General Risenhower is awarded the French highest Military Medal, the Croix de Guerre, picture shows:
