Last Bishop in Satellite Countries. Expelled from Bucharest in July 50. Elevated to rank Archbishop. Expulsion was from Rumanian Peoples Republic. Given 3 days notice to clear with staff. Accused of using his diplomatic position to interfere in affairs of Republic. He is 56. Parents Patrick James O'Hara and mother Margaret Barney. Irish pioneers of the mining

During this parade you will find 3 panning shots on NEW YORK team - you will see 1<sup>st</sup> man has blood streaming from eye.

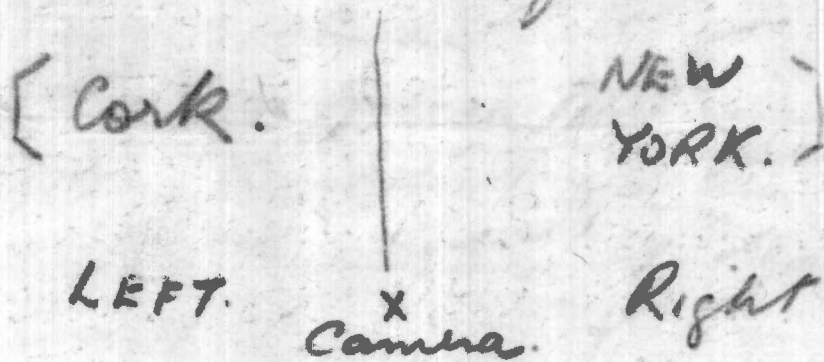
2<sup>nd</sup> man is done up in plaster, and 3<sup>rd</sup> has head completely bandaged - all
