General Ridgway, arrived by plane from the U.S. 30 take over General Eisenhower's post as Commander in Chief of Atlantic Pact Forces,

General Midgway stopping out of his plane is accompanied by Mrs. Ridgway and his son. He is greeted at the foot of the stairs by General Eisenhower, and French Defense Minister René PLEVEN, and Marshall Montgomery, as well as officersef SHAPE headquarters representing all European Nations of the Atlantic Pact.

He walks accross the square towards the airdreme Station where Mr. René Pleven, speaking in the microphone introduices him to other officers and personnalities, by a fiw words of welcome; General Ridgway answers him and speaks of his mission in Europe.

The official cortege then starts towards Paris, going through Place de la Concorde and up the Champs Elysées, to Etcile where General Ridgway's first official act is to lay a wreath to the uncknown soldier's grave.
