POWERS AGREE GERMAN PACT

At Bonn, West Germany and the three Great Powers meet to sign a pact to end Western Occupation. Mr. Eden represents Britain; Dean Acheson, America; and Robert Schuman, France - the country most concerned. Dr. Adenauer, as President, signs for the West German Federal Republic. The agreement becomes effective when it and the European Defence Community Treaties have been ratified.

France required special assurance from Britain and America, which will concern Mr. Eden (who now signs for Britain) and his American opposite number, Dean Acheson.

The pact brings West Germany into Western Defence. The fact that Communists crossed the Berlin border to riot, shows that the Reds believe that West Germany will stand for peace and security in the West - which is the aim of the pact.
