The Glasgow police bagpipers are visiting their colleagues of the Paris Police, and on the occasion of their three days trip to Paris have given several concerts in the Tuileries and Luxemburg Gardens.

From their Hotel in Avenue Hoche, in full array and blowing their pipes, the Glasgow policemen go across place de l'Etoile for a service at the Irish Church in Paris.

In the afternoon a concert was given by the Scotsmen in the Gardens of the Luxemburg; in the presence of their Chief. After music, the Scottish dances.

The next day, in a short ceremony in the Square in front of Paris Prefecture de Police, a ~~Brk~~ Representative of the British Embassy laid a wreath to the fallen policemen in war or underground action.
