## VENEZUELA'S METROPOLIS

One of the most ambitious building projects over planned is Venesuela's Avenida Bolivar. A scale model shows what the three million dellar city of the future will look like. Already a quarter of the actual city has been completed. It runs a full mile through the centre of Garacas, capital of Venesuela, and designers hope that one day all Caracas will look like this. The new city will have four different traffic levels, seen here under construction. Historic buildings, like the church seen in the background, are still preserved. In the new buildings, windows are deeply recessed to give maximum protection from sun and weather. New, where slow-moving ex-carts once pledded, eight-lane highways speed traffic through Venesuela's new metropolis, Avenida Bolivar.
