Prince Aly Khan is with Madame Volterra and George Raft's floating around - you'll see him in close-up in a moment.

It's a field of fifteen but TULYAR's clear favourite as they face the tapes. MAT DE COCACNE, the French flyer, is giving a let of trouble. ZUCCHERO get a kick in one of his flare-ups.

MAT IE COCACRE is left at the tapes. You'd think he'd have a crack for £23,000! It's only a mile-and-a-half!

Out in the country it's Gordon on LE SAGE leading GAY TIME, with TULYAR well placed and ZUCCHERO going well in spite of his kick.

Rounding the bend to the straight it's WORDEN II from GAY TIME.

Now Charlie Smirke's just beginning to move up on TULYAR. It looks like a terrific race. Piggett's taking GAY TIME past WORDEN. Watch how smoothly TULYAR's coming up. Smirke's timing his race perfectly. Half a furleng from the post GAY TIME responds gamely to Piggott but TULYAR's just that much better.

TULYAR wins by a neck to make his total winnings over £67,0000 breaking all British records - thanks to the help of the little man on top - Charlie Smirke. Said Charlie, "Tulyar's a magnificent horse."
