COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

THE QUEEN AND THE CHILDREN, THE DUKE AND PRINCESS MARGARET ARRIVE AT BALLATER STATION ON THEIR WAY TO BALMORAL CASTLE FOR THEIR HOLIDAYS IN THE WORST RAIN STORM THAT THEY HAVE HAD IN TWENTY YEARS WHICH CURTAILED THE CEREMONY IN THE STATION SQUARE.

THE DUKE IN BLINDING RAIN INSPECTS THE GUARD OF HONOUR THE SECOND BATT OF THE BLACK WATCH WHO ARE ON GUARD AT BALMORAL.

THE DUTCHESS OF KENT AND CHILDREN ALSO ARRIVED.

OVER A 1000 PEOPLE STOOD IN THE POURING RAIN TO SEE THE ROYAL PARTY ARRIVE.

OUTSIDE THE STATION AT BALLATER I HAD GREAT TROUBLE WITH THE POLICE. I WAS GIVEN TO UNDERSTAND WE WERE ALLOWED TO BE ABOUT 7 YDS FROM THE ENTRANCE FOR THE ARRIVAL BUT THE POLICE PUSHED US ~~BACK~~ BACK 14 YDS. I MOVED TO GET ANOTHER CAMERA WITH A LONGER LENS TO IT AND I WAS PUSHED AND THREATENED BY AN INSPECTOR THAT IF I MOVED AN INCH I WOULD BE THROWN OUT BEHIND THE CROWDS.

I WANTED TO PROTEST TO THE CHIEF CONSTABLE BUT HE WOULD NOT LET ME. EVENTUALLY I REPORTED THE MATTER TO THE CHIEF CONSTABLE BUT ALL I GOT FROM HIM THAT HE WOULD LOCK IN TO IT. HE HAD HAD HIS INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE HIGH UP WHICH SHOWS YOU THE POLICE CAN DO WHAT THEY LIKE IF YOU HAVE NOT GOT THE ROYAL PERMIT

I WAS ALSO STOPPED FROM DOING THE INSPECTION AS YOU WILL SEE BY THE PICTURE.

INSIDE THE STATION WAS ALRIGHT THE STATION POLICE WERE GOOD TO US.
