"MEE-TOOKI" reft lemented.

POSITIVE DEVELOPED: 56 meters - 188 ft

A SOft by 41 ft reft on which a young British mures and five men hope to "do a Kon-Tiki" across the Mediterranean, was launched yesterday from an island on the Seine seven piles off Paris, and cheers, bottle waving and comercie...

The raft was christianed the "KKN TOOKI" by a film astress, Genevieve Jounet known in France as "Miss white teeth" for her reles in a series of publicity film. A bottle of changeges was provided for the coremeny, but Mr. Michael Jones ex-RAF pilot officer and a member of the error confessed that there was little changeges in the bottle, as they had drank it beforehand.

Although the raft was only three yards from the water's edge it took 5/4 of an hour and a dive for Mr. Jones to get it aflect. There was no slipway, so the arew used a four-whooled capt and heavy wooden rellars.

The KEN TOOKI, built in less them a mouth, floated bravely, but was slightly down front. The only girl of the adventurous erow, Mass Muriel Grand declared that was alright at it would be restified by the weight of the stores and the water tanks.
