

CALIFORNIAN EARTHQUAKE

California's second earthquake within a month jars Bakersfield, a small town 85 miles from Los Angeles. For ten terrible seconds there was an ominous rumble. The ground heaved and buildings collapsed. Two were killed and thirty injured.

Now Bakersfield citizens, who faced the disaster without panic, return to start rebuilding the shops and homes shattered by the earthquake.
