

CELEBRITIES AT PREMIERE OF "ANGELS ONE-FIVE"

A guard of honour, mounted by the 2502 Ulster L.A.A. squadron, presented arms as the Prime Minister, Lord Brookesborough, arrived at the Ritz Cinema, Belfast, for the Northern Ireland premiere of "Angels One Five," the stirring film tribute to the gallant "Few" who won the Battle of Britain.
