Roll 1. 90 ft. Order and Description of Shots:
(Various shots of end ne being replaced in "Crusader" after modification finished on boat.

Commander Bray (Chief Official Observer), Marine Motoring Association, and Mr. G. Maclellan, Surveyor (he measured the official mile), studying chart and noting position of the Mile Post.

Rall 2. 100 ft.

Mr.L.H.Lumby, official timekeeper - is rowed ashore to his post, with official observer, Mr.N.H.Buckley.
Mr.P.Mayne, senior official timekeeper and observer

Mr.F.B.Lydall, and Commander Bray - land at the timing post. Shot of Mr.Mayne and Mr.Lydall timing past their point.

Roll 3.

Commander Bray and George Eyston confer in the trawler.

Shot over timekeeper's shoulder to cut with last shot of Roll 2.

"Crusader" is brought out for the last minute engine tests
on land - various shots of fuelling, starting, etc.

Roll 4. 100 ft. (Shots of engine testing - general view - ruffled water.)
(John Cobb and Mr. Bennett, Chief De Havilland Engineer confer (on "Crusader".
("Crusader" suspended mid-air.

Roll 5,100ft. The "Crusader" is put into the water at dawn - various shots.

John Cobb climbs into the cockpit of the "Crusader" and is towed out into the Dock.

"Crusader" returns after 1st timed attempt.
John Cobb sits disappointedly on the cockpit after the attempt which averaged 173 m.p.h.
Cobb climbs out of cockpit.
Close-up of John Cobb.
