**Overrail Transportation "Skyroad"**

For the first time the "Skyroad" of the future was demonstrated to the public on a trial track near Cologne.

On a one-rail oval track of wire-concrete, the "Skyroad" the new train achieves the astounding test speed of 140 kms/hours in curves of 130 m radius. A minimum travelling speed of 300 kms/hour is expected on straight stretches.

Initiator of the development is the Swedish financier and philanthropist Axel-Werner-Gren. He declares, "I have always been interested in social progress and in my opinion a higher standard of living can be achieved most effectively by greater efficiency of the distribution system. If we can develop a quicker, more efficient and cheaper means of transportation, we can cut prices.
