

DUKE BEGINS TOUR OF BRITAIN

Beginning a crowded list of engagements that will take him from the North of Scotland to the West of England, the Duke of Edinburgh opens the Glen Affric scheme at Fasnakyle, Inverness-shire. Water power is one of Scotland's most vital resources, and with this latest development all the Highlands' electricity needs will be supplied, plus a margin to help out Central Scotland when necessary. Now the North of Scotland Hydro Electric Board will be able to produce enough electricity to save half a million tons of coal - a whole week's output in the Scottish pits.

The energetic Duke goes tirelessly about his duties. With the Coronation only eight months away he takes an increasing share of Royal responsibility. Now he has a rank worthy of his importance to the nation and he is indeed Britain's "First Gentleman."
