## ORDER OF PROCEEDINGS ON THE OCCASION OF THE RE-OPENING BY THE RT. HON. THE LORD MAYOR OF THE NORTH-WEST CORNER OF THE CENTRAL CRIMINAL COURT.

Tuesday, 14th October, 1952.

The guests (other than those taking part in the Procession mentioned below) will be directed to their seats in the Main Hall.

The Lord Mayor and the Sheriffs will arrive at the Lord Mayor's Entrance at 12 noon, and will be met by the Chairman and a Deputation of the City Lands Committee.

The Lord Chief Justice and Her Majesty's Judges will arrive at the Lord Mayor's Entrance at 12.5 p.m. and will be received by the Lord Mayor and Sheriffs.

The Company will remain seated during the following proceedings:-

- (1) The Chairman of the City Lands Committee will invite the Lord Mayor to unveil a Tablet to commemorate the re-opening of the North-West Corner of the Central Criminal Court premises following the repair of war damage.
  - (2) The Lord Mayor will unveil the Tablet and deliver an Address.
  - (3) The Lord Chief Justice will deliver an Address.
- (4) The Chairman of the City Lands Committee will present to the Lord Mayor some of those who have been engaged in the restoration of the building.

The proceedings will conclude with a prayer by the Bishop of London.
