The Queen paid a "private" visit to Shrewsbury School in recognition of the School's Fourth Centenary.

It was founded in 1552, receiving its Charter from Edward VI. It was situated in the town until 1882, when it was moved out up to its present position on "Kingsland", overlooking the River Severn just outside the town.
