

DUTCH HONOUR WELSH FALLEN

Near the Cathedral at Hertogenbosch, little town in Holland, local people gather to pay homage, with dignitaries from Britain and the Netherlands, and to watch Major-General Coleman unveil a statue to the memory of the men of the 53rd Welsh Division who fell during the liberation of their country.
