Unveiling monument "Welsh Infantry" at 's-Hertogenbosch. 25.10.'52.

On the 25th October in 's-Hertogenbosch, the capital of the southern province of North Brabant, a monument was unveiled in honour of the "Welsh Infantry".

Men of this Regiment liberated 's-Hertogenbosch in the last month of 1944. It was an imposing ceremony, at which assisted various important people from The Netherlands and from abroad.



