OLYMPIC STADIUM DESIGN:

Carlton Football Ground is the site for the 1956 Olympic Games -- but in a brand new stadium. From 115 entries organizers chose a design by Melbourne architect Frank Heath who discusses it with the chairman of the Olympic Games Control Committee, Mr. A. W. Coles. And here's the winning design. This magnificent stadium will cost about £1,000,000 and first tenders for its construction will be called shortly.

The oval itself will be about 600 x 500 feet. Apart from cafeterias, dining rooms, athletes accommodation and gymnasiums, the two tiered stands will seat 150,000 people. Melbourne in three years will have a stadium to compete with those anywhere in the world.
