Casabianca, Morocco December 10. 1952 156 meters - 520 ft

The situation in Casabianes, wich was the seene of street battles and rists resulting from action of Communist led Moroscan mobs after assembleation of the Tunisian Labor loader in Tunis, is returning to normal.

But for the numerous Morecean police and Desert treeps pabrolling in the streets, and checking papers of people, there is no trase of the bloody actions of Sunday and Henday last. Hewever one can still see harnt down trucks and traces of the furtous assaults against suropeans in Casabiansa.

Yesterday took place the funerals of four of the French Casabianca residents who were assessingted by the nobs, in the presence of a large eroud and French Resident General Guillame, in the Cathedral of Casabianes : Our Lady of the Secred Heart.
