BRITISH JETS POWER FRENCH PLANES

French aircraft factories are rapidly turning to jet aircraft production. The Dassault works in the South are hard at work producing Mysteres and Ouragans to equip French fighter squadrons. British Rolls Royce engines are fitted under special licence. The Mysteres have made headline news by their frequent flights through the sound barrier. Now test-pilots take over to put the new models through their first trials.

The Mysteres have proved so successful that the American Air Force has ordered a large number for use as interceptor fighters. Now comes a fly-past of Ouragans. The stabilisers on their fuel tanks are miniatures of the aircraft's fin and rudder.

These fighters (the finest jet aircraft yet produced in France) are worthy additions to the defence forces now being built up by the Western Powers.
