General done.

- (a) Suffolks marching through town with fixed bayonets from Campbell Road preceded by the Band of the Federation Police Force.
- (b) Gen. Templer taking the salute as they pass the Secretariat.
- (c) They stop at the Cenotaph and their C.O., Lt.Col.P.A. Morcombe, lays a wreath in memory of the men of the Suffolks who have fallen in battles against terrorists.
- (d) March to the Railway Station.
- (e) Parade of their Colours in the Station to the tune of their Regimental March, played by the Band of the Queen's Own Royal West Kents.
- (f) The Sultan of Selangor arrives to bid them farewell.
- (g) Gen. Templer follows 1 minute later and inspects the Guard of Honour formed by the Royal West Kents.
- (h) H.E. greeting the Suffolks Officers.
- (i) As the train pulls away the Band plays "Auld Lang Syne".

The Federation Police Force Band accompanies the parade up to the Cenotaph and the West Kents Band takes over at the Station.
