COUNTESS VISITS RED CROSS

The Countess of Limerick, Vice Chairman of the British Red Cross Society, arrives at Kuala Lumpur in pouring rain, and is greeted by Lady Templer, wife of General Sir Gerald Templer, High Commissioner of Malaya.
