ORADOUR CONDEMNED REPRIEVED

The people of Strasbourg march through the city's streets in protest against death and gaol sentences passed on thirteen Alsations for their part in the Nazi massacre of Oradour-Sur-Glane. Now the French Government have quashed the sentences - an act that will appease the angry people of Alsace who declared a state of mourning for the condemned. At Strasbourg's war memorial, many relatives of the imprisoned Alsations join with the town's leading citizens in protest against the sentences. Now the guilty will be freed.
