ROYAL PALACE TEA PARTY

More than fifty children, evacuees from some of the worst flooded areas of Holland, gather at the Royal Palace near the Hague for their own party. In the cinema-room of the Palace, a Punch and Judy show is among the amusements provided for the young guests.

Her Majesty Queen Juliana herself helps to entertain the children, many of whom lost their homes and families in the flood disaster. Her elder daughter, Crown Princess Beatrix hands round drinks to the evacuees whose ages range between five and seven.

Little Princess Margriet, the Queen's ten-year-old daughter, distributes squeakers and paper hats. For a few hours the tragedy through which these kiddies have passed is forgotten in the laughter and excitement of this Royal party.
