

EDINBURGH BOXING TROPHY

Sculptor Vasco Lazzolo has been given the job of creating "The Duke of Edinburgh's Boxing Trophy," which will be awarded to the winning team at the Transatlantic Boys Amateur Boxing Match, soon to be held in London. Under the skilled hands of Lazzolo, the Trophy emerges. His model is a 17-year-old Londoner, Leslie Steers, who has entered for the contest. So maybe those fists of his will help win the bust of himself.

Quickly Lazzolo completes the head of the figure. He doesn't aim to produce an exact likeness of his model, but intends to give the features an individuality of their own. Later the finished bust will be cast in bronze and, in that form, will be presented to the team, either from New York or London, whichever wins the contest. Now Lazzolo declares his work is done. Recently this brilliant young artist completed a bust of the Duke of Edinburgh. Soon the Duke (who donated "The Edinburgh Boxing Trophy") will, himself, be making the award in the ring.
