PREEDOM OF CITY FOR K.O.S.B.

Growds gather at Whitesands, Dumfries to greet Her Royal Highness the Duchess of Gloucester. On behalf of the Royal Burgh of Dumfries, Prevost Bell welcomes the Duchess. Her Royal Highness is the Colonel-in-Chief of the King's Own Scottish Borderers. Detachments of the Reg iment are on parade today to receive the Burgh's greatest henour - the freedom of entry into Dumfries.

The inspection over, the freedem coremony begins. The Provost invites Her Reyal Highness to accept the scroll which confers upon the K.O.S.Bs the right to enter Dumfries on coremonial occasions and march through the streets with drums beating, colours flying and bayons to fixed.

On behalf of the regiment, the Duchess of Glowester signs the Burgess Roll and the ceremeny of conferment draws to a close.

Now, with beyone is fixed and colours flying, the King's Own Scottish Borderers (many of whom have given such gallant service in Korea) march through the centre of the Boyal Burgh.

Past the Duchess of Gloucester swing men of the K.O.S.Bs upon whom Dumfries has conferred its most coveted privilege.
