REFUGEE PROBLEM GROWS

Special camps in the Western Sector of Berlin show the tragic effects of the cold war. All these people have journeyed from the Soviet controlled sector of the city through the Iron Curtain, in the hope of finding freedom in the Western zone. Desperately the authorities try to find them accommodation, but every day, as many as three thousand more stream in. All have to be strictly checked, for many Communist agents are believed to be entering the Western zone with the refugees.

Inside the camps, conditions are bad. There is little water to wash clothes, and few places where they can be dried. Yet still they come to be free from Communist rule. Now Berlin authorities are appealing to the United States to help relieve the plight of these political refugees.
