Shots follow with play from The Aberdeen goal.

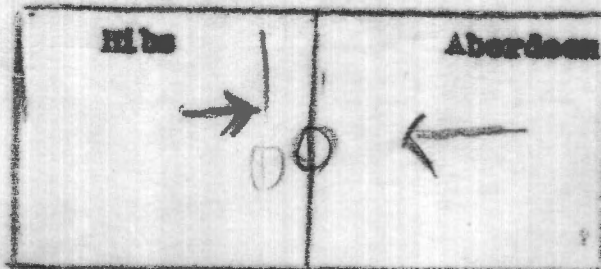
Roll two continues from the same position, fingers across lens denotes half time, then the rest of this roll and roll three continues from the Hibs goal.
