SUBJECT: Duke of Edinburgh with the Army. Footage: 1000 ft.

Location: Hohne and Soltau Training Grounds, Germany

Order and Description of Shots:

HP3. Shots of the Duke's arrival - Guard of Honour and several shots
100 ft. by floodlight (these taken for experimental purposes, as very
poor light)

Roll Duke, dressed in Battledress, Field Marshal's Uniform, arrives by
1, 1A, car at HOHNE, sees field firing by 17/21 Lancers. Then climbs
2, 3, 4. into tank and fires at targets.

(500ft.) Duke, at different place, takes part in mock battle to take a
ridge - (in Centurion tank) - and speaks to tank crews afterwards -
drives tank.

Note: All at Hohne.

Numbered At SOLTAU, Duke with 7th Armoured Division, watches demonstrations
Rolls at various points - 5th Royal Tank Regiment firing from camouflaged
5 & 5 positions:- Seaforth Highlanders in attack - Duke speaks to
& 2 camouflaged man -

others, Duke watches mortar firing - gets into trench and shots in
400ft. trench - 1st Bn. Royal Hampshire Regiment, and 1st Bn. Essex
Reg., dug in.

Duke sees Mechanical mine laying - flies off by helicopter.
(Mine laying by 21st Field Engineer Regt. Royal Engineers.

Rolls shot in this order:-

1, 1A, 2, 3, 4, 6, 5 and two un-numbered.
