Order and Description of Shots:

HP3. Shots of the Duke's arrival - Guard of Honour and several shots 100 ft. by floodlight (these taken for experimental purposes, as very poor light)

Roll car at HOHNE, sees field firing by 17/21 Lancers. Then climbs 1,14, into tank and fires at targets.

2.3.4. Duke, at different place, takes part in mock battle to take a (500ft.) ridge - (in Conturion tank) - and speaks to tank crows afterwards drives tank. Note: All at Hohme.

Numbat SOLMAN, Duke with 7th Armoured Division, watches demonstrations at various points - 5th Royal Tank Regiment firing from camouflaged positions:- Seaforth Highlanders in attack - Duke speaks to 5 & 5 Duke watches wonter firing

Duke watches mortar firing - gets into trench and shots in trench - 1st Ba. Royal Hampshire Regiment, and 1st Ba. Essex Reg., dug in. Duke sees Mechnical mine laying - flies off by helicopter.

(Mine laying by 21st Field Engineer Regt. Royal Engineers.

REMARKS: Rolls shot in this order:-1, 1A, 2, 3, 4, 6, 5 and two un-numbered.
