

PLYMOUTHQUEEN MOTHER PRESENTS COLOUR

At Plymouth, Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother presents a new Queen's colour, on behalf of Her Majesty, to Plymouth Naval Command. The colour is a silk white ensign, bearing the crown and royal cypher.
