

RUGBY: ENGLAND v. SCOTLAND

The Scottish fifteen take the field at Twickenham in their match with England. The Calcutta Cup is at stake so it promises plenty of excitement. Scotland kick-off straight into touch. Almost at once England show they mean business. White starts a run.

A pass to Regan who dashes on ahead. But Swan cuts in and brings him down only a few feet from the line.

Into the second half, with Scotland trying to put matters right. Chick Henderson is tackled by English defenders, and play swings back towards the Scottish half. The ball goes to Basley, but McMillan brings him down.

Stirling robs Dorward and races for the Scots line to touch down with Ian Thomson still round his neck. Nim Hall takes the kick, and it's over the bar. England are drawing well ahead now and are showing no signs of letting up. Davies attacks. He's tackled, but Butterfield is there. Watch his run.

And there's another one in the bag for England. The conversion is again taken by Nim Hall - and he does it again.

Lockhart leads a Scottish attack.

Dawson has it. He tries to break through the solid England defence. A pass to Henderson, who races through to chalk up another one for Scotland.

Ian Thomson takes the conversion - and through it goes. Scotland have now got eight points but they've still a long way to go to catch up. New Woodward starts a run for England. Bruce Lockhart tries to stop him - but it's no good and Woodward touches down over the line.

Hall converts again and the final score of 26 points to 8, gives England an overwhelming victory - and the Calcutta Cup.
