

MONTY VISITS U.S. ARMY

Field Marshal Viscount Montgomery, Deputy Supreme Commander of NATO forces is welcomed to Fort Benning in Georgia by American army chiefs. Some of the United States' most modern weapons - many of them still on the secret list - are unveiled for Monty's keen inspection.

Now helicopters fly past to demonstrate how field guns can be carried into battle. For Monty's benefit, the Air Force joins in with rocket-firing fighters strafing targets on the range.

A full scale display of much of the war equipment held in reserve at Fort Benning gives Field Marshal Montgomery a clear picture of the striking power of America's combat forces. Discussions with United States' service chiefs are helping Monty to size up the fighting strength of the Western Allies.
