FIELD MARSHAL VISCOUNT MONTGOMERY, DEPUTY COMMANDER OF THE NATO FORCES, VISITS FORT BENNING, APRIL 3 AND 4, 1953.

1-Field Marshal Montgomery arrives at Lawson Field, Fort Benning, and is welcomed by Major General Guy S. Meley, Jr., commanding officer of Fort Benning, and Lt. Gen. A.R. Belling, of the 3rd Army Headquarters.

2-Field Marshal Montgomery is given a 17-gun salute. In foreground Montgomery and Gen. Meley.

3-Field Marshal Montgomery and Gen. Meley, of Fort Benning, inspect troops. Also seen reviewing the troops.

4-Field Marshal Montgomery's headquarters while at Fort Benning. Note British flag flying over door and Montgomery leaving quarters.

5-Field Marshal Montgomery and Gen. Meley talk informally in front of officers quarters.

6-Montgomery witnesses Infantry support weapons demonstration. Montgomery in bleachers stand watches demonstration with Army officers and candidate students. CU of Montgomery in stands.

7-High explosive and Field Artillery demonstration, (This and the following scenes witness by Montgomery):
a) Artillery delivered by helicopters and fired by artillery men.

8-Monty is interviewed by the press.

9-Monty observes equipment display.
