Stationed nine miles from KLANG, " A " Company 1st Bn The Worcestershire Regt in an old village once called " TELOK " now renamed KAMPONG NORTON. "Kampung" is the Malayan name for village, and "NORTON" is the Worcestershire's depot in England.

Shots show a patrol of ten ( 10 ) men and one ( 1 ) officer leaving the company area transported by armoured truck and then setting off into the jungle on a typical daylight patrol.

The Worcesters have been in Malaya since MAY 1950.

L/S Patrol loading arms before boarding armoured truck.

C/U PRIVATE SID LATHAM OF ALTRINCHAM, a National Service man aged 20, loading his rifle.

L/S and M/S Patrol boarding armoured truck.

ROLL TWO.

M/S from inside armoured truck.

L/S patrol leaving truck to enter the jungle

L/S Patrol walking along jungle track.

M/S Patrol scout ~~EXTRE~~ PRIVATE KEITH SHRIGLEY and Patrol Commander  
2LIEUT JAMES MARSHAL comes into shot.

M/SScout and patrol commander

C/U PRIVATE KEITH SHRIGLEY National Service man from MACCLESFIELD  
12 months in Malaya aged 20.

ROLL THREE.

M/S Patrol moves off again past camera.

L/S Patrol stop for a rest and a " Brew Up ".

M/S Bren gun section move into resting position.

M/S Bren section two shot PRIVATE JOE SPITTLE OF DUDLEY WORCESTER  
national service man age 19 a navy in civilian life.

A. and L/CPL JOE GANDY OF DROITWICH SPA National service man 13  
months in Malaya. Market Gardener in civilian life ( seen filling  
tin from water bottle.)

ROLL FOUR. HAS NUMBER THREE TO START PLEASE WATCH

ROLL FOUR ( has number three to start please watch -)

- B M/S Patrol Commander 2 LT JAMES MARSHALL OF PERSHORE WORCESTER and CPL GEORGE PHILLIPS OF APPLEBY MAGNA, LEICESTER (a farmer ) lighting up their "Tommy Cookers" to brew tea.
- C C/U Lighting cooker
- C C/U CPL GEORGE PHILLIPS
- D C/U Tea ~~with~~ Water
- E L/S 2LT JAMES MARSHALL
- E L/S Cooker in foreground and PRIVATE DEREK JONES OF BURSLEM, STOKE ON TRENT, 15 months in Malaya, works in iron foundry back home
- E C/U JONES.
- F M/S (LEFT) PRIVATE HAROLD HODGKINSON OF TUNSTALL STOKE AND PRIVATE SID LATHAM OF ALRTINCHAM both 13 months in Malaya lighting cigarettes.
- F C/U Tea brewing and pan up to PRIVATE HODGKINSON.

ROLL FIVE.

- G M/S Two shot drinking tea PRIVATE HARRY SMITH OF ENFIELD age 19 one year in Malaya and PRIVATE FRANK ALLSOP OF WORCESTER AGED 19.
- M/S BILL JORDAN wet through and a bit jungle happy ( taken by 2/lt James Marshall )
- L/S and M/S Patrol crossing ditch
- M/S Patrol getting out of truck on return.
- L/S Playing with company mascot a pet monkey CPL PHILLIPS holding same and C/U Monkey ( with Battalion nearly two years ).

ROLL SIX.

- M/S CPL PHILLIPS taking off his jungle boots
- L/S and C/S
- C/U "A" Compnay sign
- L/S Camp area.

Camera very wet after ROLL FOUR (4) did my best to keep rain off lense.

Coverage of jungle limited through lack of light, coverage a bit scrappy but conditions were a bit tough for my first experience in the jungle.
