Having passed suddenly away in his residence at Estoril, in the "Vila" Marisol, King Carol II received from the Portuguese Government all the honours due to his hierarchy as a sovereign and grand cross of the three orders, the greatest Portuguese decoration.

His body has been conveyed to the royal pantheon of São Vicente where lie the late sovereigns of the house of Bragança, still his relatives, as Carol was great-great-grand-son of the Queen Maria the second of Portugal, in direct male line.

The late King was accompanied to his last abode, besides his widow, princess Helen of Greece, by the representatives of the Portuguese Chief of the State and of the Chief of the Government, the British Ambassador, representing H.M. the Queen Elisabeth the second, members of the Rumanian royal family, as well as of the Jugoslavian royal family, of the house of the Hohenzollern, Portuguese authorities and members of the Diplomatic Corps, etc.

The military honours due to the deceased were rendered by a battalion of the Republican National Guards, his body having been escorted by a squadron of cavalry cars of the same guard.
