He lines up, presents his plate for the food then sits down and cats it with great en joyment, with U.S. Japanese Ambassador A raki on one side of him and Canadian Government representative Noward Measures on his other side. After lunch, the Prince goes to the chips bridge and sees the skyline of his first American oitygSan Francisco, with its giant bay bridge. A fireboat sends up streams of water in welcome. At the dock a huge crowd waves American and Japanesed flags and should of banzai are loud and happy. Just before he debarks he is velcomed by its Gov. Earl Warren (Gov. of California).
