In Kerea, Operation Little Switch is the code name for the exchange of sick and wound prisoners of war. A train, carrying simulated U. N. P.W.s in a full-dress rehearsal for the momentous transfer, reaches Munsan. At a siding, ambulances — under the eyes of Admiral Daniel, chief of the Allied truce team, are waiting. Transferred to the minimum vehicles, the men are guarded by the soldiers of all nations.

Some are able to walk inxiku in the thour of their deliverance.

At the front, there is no deliverance from the wages of war.

Men go into forward into battle and — inevitably — some are carried back in stretchers in a war that goes on day and night.
