An angle shot by Aberdeen, No.9, is deflected by Rangers goal-keeper.
Aberdeen, No.8, intercepts a pass from the right wing, but shoots over the bar.
Cross kick from Aberdeen No.9 gets past the post, but it is not a goal.
A long movement started by Aberdeen No.9 ends as a very poor shot.
Aberdeen, No.11, beats Young and cross by - a very weak shot.
The Rangers keeper kicks off.
Close shot of Rangers keeper, with sticking plaster on his ear.
Crowd reaction to the Rangers' first goal.
Close shot of above.
Crowd watching play.

Three crowd shots.

Roll 3. (contd).

A corner for Rangers, in the first second of the second half. Close-up of Aberdeen's No.5, who in desperation kicks the ball out of touch.

An Aberdeen player writhes on the ground with pain, whilst play carries on.
Close shot of crowd.

Roll 4.

Rangers, No.9, tries a narrow angle shot at the goal, but it goes wide.

A very exciting moment on the Aberdeen goal-mouth.
