PARIS FIRE

In the Paris suburb of Colombes, fire breaks out in a large yard where thousands of rubber tyres are stacked. Quickly it becomes a raging inferme and the column of smoke spreads more than six hundreed feet wide and sixty feet high, fireman from seventeen stations are rushed to the scene.

Despite every effort by the firefighters, the blane blocks the Paris to Le Havre reilway line. Many of the firemen are overcome by the heavy fumes, though there are no fatal easualties.

Sabstage was suspected at first, but now police believe that the sum reflecting on a piece of glass began the fire. Details of the damage have yet to be revealed, but it is estimated that many millions of frames worth of tyres have been destroyed, in one of the biggest blazes over seen in Paris.
