- a. Opens with a sequence on making of 2 caskets which will contain addresses from the Federation and the Crown Settlements. These caskets are made by boys of the Govt Trade School.
- b. Selection of designs for border ornaments.
- c. Showing addresses in preparation stages. 10 craftsmen of the Fed. Survey Dept are working on them. On the occasion of the coronation of the late King George VI the large numbers of addresses presented were exhibited at the Kensington Art Galleries and it was acknowledged in the English Press that those from Malaya excelled in their craftsmanship those from any other country within the Empire.
- d. Shots of completed illuminated addresses.

Description of 4 Loyal Addresses.

1. From Fed of Malaya. This message is in two languages, English on left column and Jawi on the right, with ornamental border of Mohammedan design.
2. From the Rulers of the 9 Malayan States. Two addresses prepared, one in Jawi and the other a
3. translation from the Jawi script into English. These also have borders of Mohammedan design.
4. From the Settlements of Penang and Malacca. This message is in English only, with a border of Gothic design.
