**Commonwealth Parliamentary Association
Luncheon, Westminster Hall, May 27th
1953.**

I wish to draw your attention to the following regulations concerning Press photography, B.B.C., Television and Newsreel coverage of the above Luncheon, to be attended by Her Majesty The Queen.

1. Positions allocated to photographers, newsreel, B.B.C. and Television representatives are static. No movement from assigned positions will be allowed.

2. No photography or recording will be permitted during the actual Luncheon - i.e. from the time The Queen takes her position at the High Table until the speeches commence at the end of the Luncheon.

3. Use of "flashes" will be restricted to one minute on The Queen's arrival in Westminster Hall, 12.50 p.m., and to her departure when Luncheon and speeches are concluded.

The facilities provided therefore cover three phases:-

- (a) Arrival of The Queen, presentations and assembly at High Table.
- (b) Speeches after Luncheon.
- (c) Departure of The Queen by North Door of the Hall.
